

Publication Lists from PuSH in TYPO3

1. How to prepare publications in PuSH (optional, if individual publications should be specially marked in the list)

You can enrich individual publications with additional information for presentation in the publication list.

- Log in to PuSH with your HMGU identifier
- Call up the publication you want to edit
- Switch to the "Extra Information" tab

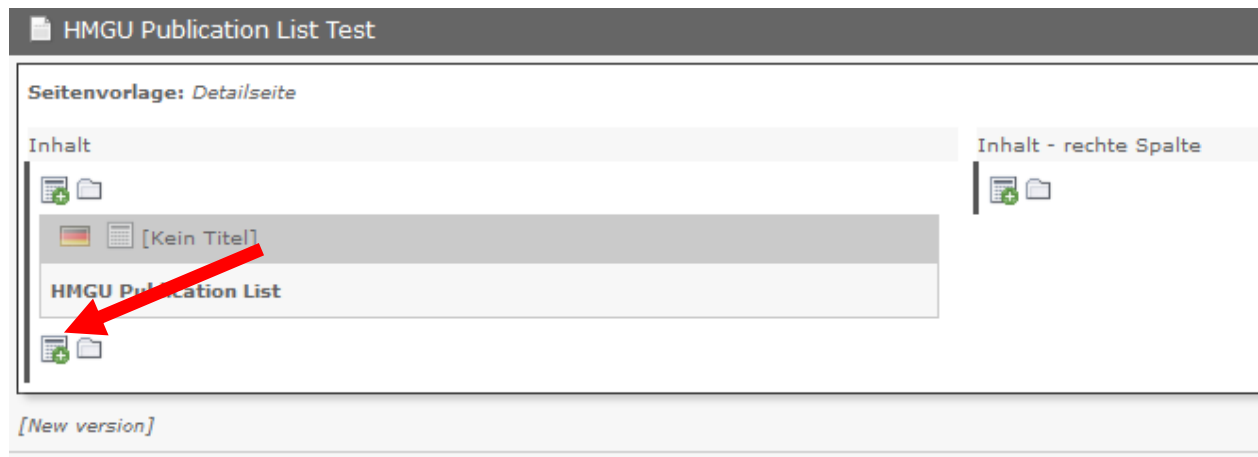

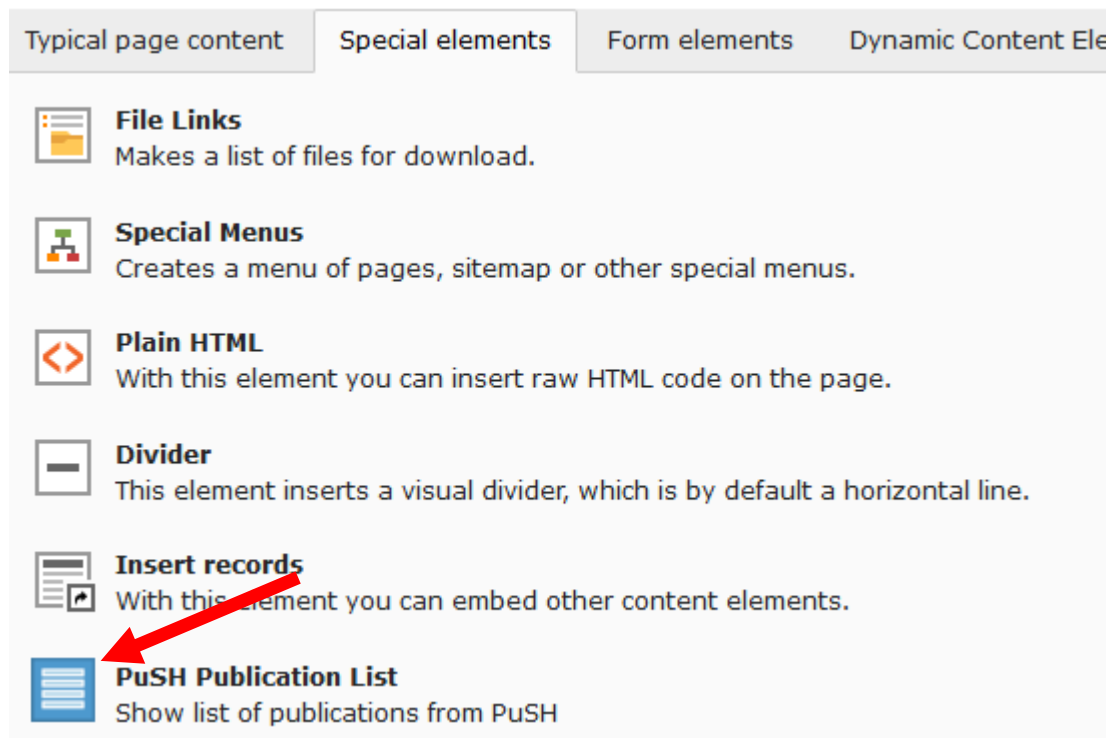
- **Tags:** Tags can be used to provide publications with keywords or categories. You can then search for them and display them in the publication list. Private tags are only visible to you personally
- **Note:** Here you can enter your own note or additional information about the publication. You can also search for them afterwards or output them in the publication list. Private notes are only visible to you personally
- **Hide publication:** Select the item "Do not display on publication lists for homepage" if you do not want a publication to be displayed on your homepage.
- **Mark as special publication:** Select this option if you want to highlight the publication. It is then possible to create a special highlight-list or to give it a special formatting.

2. Insert Publication List as an Element in TYPO3

Insert a new content element at the desired position



- Select the „PuSH Publication List“ Element under “Special Elements” in the wizard



3. How to generate a Publication List in TYPO3

- In the Publication List element on the "Source Options" tab, first select the basis on which the list is to be created. If you switch between the options, you will be prompted to save and update the list. You should confirm this.

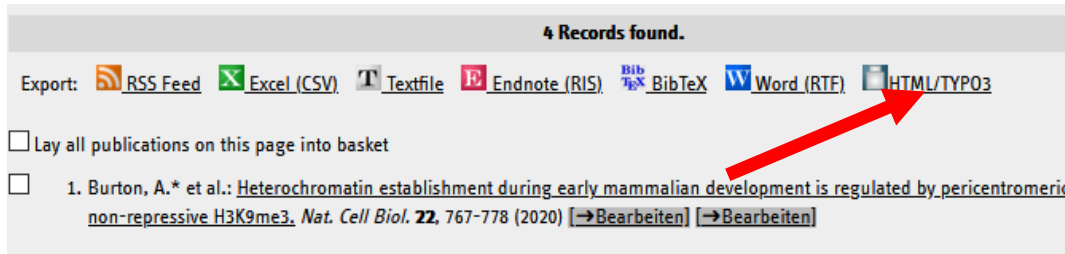

- **Individual Push-Snippet:** If the options available to you as a basis for your publication list are not sufficient, you can compile an individual query in PuSH as usual and then output it as a publication list in TYPO3.
 - Use the advanced search in PuSH to generate the desired list. Then click on HTML/TYPO3 in the export bar at the top.



- Copy the snippet you see on the next page to the clipboard and paste it into the TYPO3 element. There you can also adjust the sorting again.

4. How to format the Publication List in TYPO3

- On the "Display options" tab, you will find a wide range of options for adapting the publication list to your requirements.

Only etries starting from the following publication year

- Only entries between the following years: Select this option if you only want to list publications with a publication year in between these years.
- List only scientific articles and reviews: Select this option if you do not want non-scientific publications (like meeting abstracts, corrections, etc.) to appear in the list.
- List only publications marked as "Special Publications": Select this option if you only want to create a highlight-list of publications that you have marked as special publications in PuSH.
- Link directly to the publication via DOI (if available): Select this option if the links to the publication entries should link directly to the publisher's website via DOI. Otherwise the links will lead to the corresponding entry in PuSH.
- Divide list by years of publication (if sorted by date): Select this option if the individual publications are to be grouped by years (by a corresponding heading with year number).
- Show anchor menu based on years at top (if divided by years): Select this option if you want a menu at the top of the list to jump directly to the desired year.
- Own author name(s) in bold: Select this option if the names of your own authors should be displayed in bold (according to the basic selection in the list).
- Mark external authors with *: Choose this option if you want external authors to be marked separately.
- Mark joint first and corresponding authors: Select this option if joint first and joint corresponding authors are to be marked with.
- Show only HMGU, first, corresponding authors and skip others: Select this option if you do not want to output the complete list of authors per publication, but only HMGU, first and corresponding authors. All other external authors are omitted in this case.
- How to highlight publications / output tags / output comments: Select these options according to your wishes for the additional information provided in PuSH. You can show or hide them.

5. How to Finalize/Update

- When you have made all settings, save the content element. Load the page with the publication list in the frontend and check the output.
- Die publication list is kept in the TYPO3 cache for faster loading. If you make changes to an existing list, you must empty the cache so that the output of the list on the website also changes.
 - Use the function "Clear cache of this page" in TYPO3. You will find it in the upper right corner, marked by a lightning bolt symbol.
