

Table S1. Restricted therapies

- Anticoagulation at full dose (vitamin K antagonists, dabigatran, heparin, hirudin, etc.). Exceptions: prophylactic low dose heparin or heparin flush as needed for maintenance of an indwelling intravenous device (e.g. enoxaparin 4000 I.U. s.c. per day)
- Antiplatelet therapy at high dose. Exceptions: prophylactic use of antiplatelet therapy (e.g. acetylsalicylic acid up to 325 mg/d, or clopidogrel at 75 mg/d or equivalent doses of other antiplatelet therapy) is allowed
- Azathioprine
- Cyclophosphamide
- Cyclosporine
- Fibrinolysis
- Pirfenidone
- Prednisone >15 mg daily OR >30 mg every 2 days OR equivalent dose of other oral corticosteroids
