Dr. Marie Standl is a head of the research group “Allergic disease epidemiology” at the Institute of Epidemiology, Helmholtz Zentrum München, Germany.

Her background is in statistics with focus on statistical modelling of high dimensional data. The scientific focus of the PhD research of Dr. Marie Standl was on genetic effects, particularly of the FADS gene cluster, and the effects of fatty acids intake on the development of allergic diseases and blood lipids levels. The current research focus includes the potential role played by gene-diet interactions and health, primarily chronic diseases during childhood, and to the influence and interplay of lifestyle (e.g., diet, physical activity), environment (e.g., greenspace and air pollution, as well as other built environment characteristics), genetic and metabolic factors.
